As you know the New Jersey Turnpike Authority's plans to construct a new monopole cellular tower at Garden State Parkway Exit 109 is something area residents have recently become aware of. Naturally as with any cell tower installation many nearby residents have concerns and questions regarding this project. I am also aware that the Turnpike Authority held a public hearing on this matter on August 2nd of 2007. However most residents were not aware of that meeting primarily because there was no personal service notice, at least that I am aware of; thus few if any attended. In addition I would anticipate that there are a number of newer residents of the area. I would like to request that the Turnpike Authority consider holding another public hearing, here in Middletown so that the concerned residents can have an opportunity to see the plans and ask questions of your experts involved in this project. T-Mobile USA, Inc., ("T-Mobile"), is licensed by the Federal Communications Commission to provide wireless services throughout the New Jersey area. T-Mobile proposes to construct a wireless facility in the median of the Garden State Parkway at Milepost 112.2, just north of Middletown Lincroft Road in Middletown Township, Monmouth County, NJ. The proposed facility will consist of the installation of a 150-foot monopole with associated equipment at its base. This facility, and others like it, will allow T-Mobile to provide high-quality wireless communications services to the people of your community.

This notice is provided pursuant to the Nationwide Programmatic Agreement for Review of Effects on Historic Properties for Certain Undertakings Approved by the Federal Communications Commission 47 C.F.R. pt.1 app. C § V(C). A notice will also be published in a local newspaper to inform the public, in addition to any requirements that are part of the zoning and permitting process.
