Enclosed please find a copy of a letter that the Lincroft Village Green Association has sent to Senator Joseph Kyrillos of the 13th District regarding the speed limit on Swimming River Road (CR50) in the Lincroft section of Middletown. We are very concerned with the 85 percentile method that the Monmouth County Engineering office and NJ DOT, Bureau of Traffic and Engineering use in setting speed limits on county roads. We feel that the other factors that the Federal Highway Commission has outlined are being ignored, compromising the safety of motorists and pedestrians alike who use Swimming River Road.

We ask for your assistance in making the temporary 35 MPH speed limit on Swimming River Road permanently set at 35 MPH.
