

RESOLUTION – SUPPORTING LINCROFT VILLAGE GREEN ASSOCIATION’S
 REQUEST FOR UNIFORM SPEED LIMIT OF 35 M.P.H. ALONG
 SWIMMING RIVER ROAD (CR50)

WHEREAS, the Lincroft Village Green Association has requested that the speed limit on Swimming River Road (CR50) be changed to a uniform 35 m.p.h., and

WHEREAS, due to the amount of traffic which traverses Swimming River Road, the fact that there are multiple speed limits compromises the safety of motorists and pedestrians, and

WHEREAS, the Association has set forth the statistics for the road in their letter of June 14, 2005 which exhibit the need for the uniformity. (A copy of which is annexed hereto)




